

PHARMACY SKILLS LABORATORY INSTRUCTORS

We are currently recruiting pharmacists to act as instructors in the professional skills labs. You do not need to be an expert in any particular area. Your predominant role is to observe and provide feedback to the students so they can improve their skills. Lab instructors are provided with information describing their roles and responsibilities for the individual labs as well as any pertinent materials for assessment and marking. All term I and II labs will be provided in-person. Lab instructors are paid an hourly wage (minimum: 3hr). REQUIREMENTS:

- Licensed pharmacist in good standing with SCPP
- Minimum 12 months of practice experience
- Orientation for instructors will be provided

Instructor Role:

Help students develop their professional practice skills by observing students, providing guidance and feedback and conducting assessments. Year 1 students learn from simulations involving simple patients with simple problems in a community pharmacy practice. Year 2 students learn from simulations involving simple patients with simple to complex problems in a community and hospital pharmacy practice. Year 3 students learn from simulations involving simple to complex patients with simple to complex problems in a variety of pharmacy practice settings.

Opportunities are available in Year 1, 2 and 3 of the PharmD program.
