



DONOR FUNDED GRADUATE AWARDS

These donor-funded awards were established by individuals and organizations to support Pharmacy and Nutrition students in research-based programs. The call for applications will be emailed to graduate students and supervisors in late spring. After eligibility is met, the primary criteria for these awards include academic achievement, demonstrated potential for research excellence, and research progress. PHARMACY

Alf Pepper Research Award

The Alf Pepper Research Award, valued at \$400, is offered in honour of Alf Pepper, a 1934 graduate of the College of Pharmacy, University of Saskatchewan, who served as Registrar of the Saskatchewan Pharmaceutical Association from 1963-1976. The award is funded through the Saskatchewan College of Pharmacists' Centennial Scholarship Fund. To be eligible, **a graduate student enrolled in, or entering, the Pharmacy program must hold a Pharmacy undergraduate degree from the College of Pharmacy and Nutrition.**

Betty Corrine Riddell and W. Murray Riddell Postgraduate Pharmacy Award

The Betty Corrine Riddell and W. Murray Riddell Postgraduate Pharmacy Award, valued at \$4,000, is made possible through a generous bequest from alumna Betty Corrine Riddell. It is available to **students holding a Pharmacy undergraduate degree from the College of Pharmacy and Nutrition and conducting graduate research in a clinical area of Pharmacy in the College. Preference will be given to applicants with a research focus in Oncology.**

Ford Postgraduate Scholarship

The Ford Postgraduate Scholarship, valued at \$4,000 was established through a bequest from the estate of the late Marguerite Ford, wife of the late Winnard Ford, founder of Ford Pharmacies. This scholarship is awarded to a student with an **undergraduate degree in Pharmacy (from any province or country) pursuing full-time graduate studies related to community pharmacy in the College, or is in a community pharmacy residency program.** This award may be held by a student for up to two years.

Ramsey Postgraduate Fellowship

The Ramsey Postgraduate Fellowship, valued at \$3,500, recognizes the contributions of the Ramsey family to the field of Pharmacy. It was established to encourage pharmacy graduates to pursue a recognized full-time postgraduate program of at least one year that advances the profession of pharmacy. The Fellowship is awarded to **a student holding a Pharmacy undergraduate degree from the College of Pharmacy and Nutrition and pursuing graduate studies in the Pharmacy program. It may also be offered to a graduate student holding a Pharmacy undergraduate degree from another Canadian Pharmacy school.**

Dr. Ed Knaus Graduate Scholarship in Pharmaceutical Research

The Dr. Ed Knaus Graduate Scholarship in Pharmaceutical Research, valued at \$450, is made possible through generous donations from Gordon Knaus and Cenovus Energy. Applicants must be conducting **research related to the innovative design, development, and/or delivery of drugs**. The award may be held by a **Pharmacy graduate student** for up to two years.

F.J. Fear Postgraduate Scholarship

The F.J. Fear Postgraduate Scholarship, valued at \$1,000, is offered to a **first-year student in the Pharmacy graduate program**.

NUTRITION

Elizabeth Helen McLeod Scholarship

This scholarship, valued at \$3,500, honours the memory of Mrs. Elizabeth Helen McLeod, who graduated from the College of Arts and Science with a specialty in home economics. Established by her family, the scholarship supports **students in the Nutrition graduate program with an undergraduate degree in Nutrition or related field**. The scholarship may be divided between two recipients.

Isabel Irwin Graduate Scholarship

Valued at \$1,000, this scholarship is awarded to **student in the Nutrition graduate program**. The award may be divided between two recipients.
