

The Little Pharmacy is a self-serve cupboard to help with everyday needs. It's stocked with personal care essentials, available free of charge to students and employees of the College of Pharmacy and Nutrition. This care cupboard is made possible with the generosity of Neighbourly Pharmacy.

What's Available? *as of September 2025*

Note. An asterisk * means a multi-use item, please bring it back after use.

Energy Boosters – Granola bars and fruit bars, bearpaw cookies, tea biscuits, microwavable meals, chocolates and hard candy, juice boxes, hot chocolate, teas, and coffee.

Minor Ailment Remedies – First aid kit, adhesive bandages, hand sanitizer bottle*, alcohol swabs, frozen cold packs, heat pack*, saltine crackers, masks, cough lozenges, antacids and bismuth tablets, peppermint and chamomile tea.

Note that acetaminophen and ibuprofen cannot be provided.

Personal Care – Dental floss sticks, toothbrushes, toothpaste, deodorants, lip balm, emery files, ear plugs, period products, razors, tissue packs, wet wipe packs, hair ties, skin care samples, and travel sized essentials.

Clothing Care and Repairs – Laundry detergent packets, wrinkle release spray*, stain remover pen*, lint roller*, sewing kit*, tape measurer*, eyeglass repair kit*, flathead screwdriver*, super glue single-use tubes (4), scissors*, duct tape*, disinfecting wipes*, compressed air duster*.

Items on Loan – Umbrella, bike lock, mini-fan, multi-head screwdriver, wireless headphones, USB-C cable/charger. *Sign out at the reception desk.*

Location and Hours: A-wing office suite 2A20, between 8-4:30 pm. Pass the reception desk and continue down the hall, the Little Pharmacy is in the kitchen seating area.

How It Works

- Single use items: Take only what you need.
- Multi-use items (*): Clean and place back borrowed items after use.
- Items on Loan: Sign out at the reception desk.
- A kettle, microwave, frozen cold packs, and first aid kit are in the kitchen.
- Inquire with reception for nearby staff trained in first aid, incl. naloxone.
