LAB SCHEDULES

Instructors may commit to one or more lab sessions for term I and/or term II based on their interest and availability. Schedule information (e.g. dates) listed below are subject to change. Lab instructors will receive a detailed schedule at the start of the term. Number of instructors scheduled each week may vary depending on lab activities.



TERM I

Instructor Role:

Help students develop their professional practice skills by observing students, providing guidance and feedback and conducting assessments.

Year 1 students learn from simulations involving simple patients with simple problems in a community pharmacy practice.

Year 2 students learn from simulations involving simple patients with simple to complex problems in community and hospital pharmacy practice.

Year 3 students learn from simulations involving simple to complex patients with simple to complex problems in a variety of pharmacy practice settings.
